

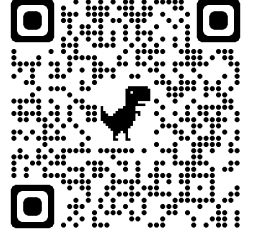


THE LEARNING ALLIANCE'S FUN FAMILY CHALLENGE "MOONSHOT TREASURE HUNT"

READ

PLAY

Find round household items and **PRETEND** they are wheels. Make up a game to move the "wheels" fast, slow, forward, backwards, up, down, etc.



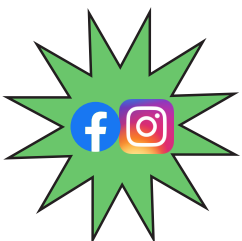
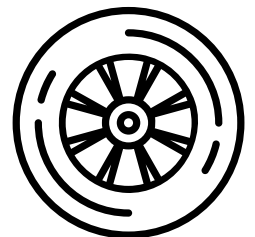
SING
